

Colorectal cancer/polyps

1 affected or FDR of affected individual

- with CRC <50
or
- with CRC and LRC
or
- with CRC and ≥ 3 adenomatous polyps
or
- ≥ 5 adenomatous polyps < 60
or
- ≥ 10 adenomatous polyps ≥ 60

≥ 2 affected individuals in family

with CRC and/or LRC at any age.
At least one is FDR of referred patient

≥ 3 affected individuals in family with LRC

Family history of a known diagnosis
e.g. Lynch, FAP

Lynch related cancers (LRC)

Colorectal cancer	Endometrial cancer
Ovarian cancer	Pancreatic cancer
Ureter cancer	Transitional cell renal pelvis cancer
Gastric cancer	Hepatobiliary tract cancer
Small bowel cancer	Glioblastoma
