

## Other tumours

### ENDOMETRIAL CANCER

- Diagnosed  $\leq 60$   
or
- Diagnosed any age with 1FDR/SDR with LRC, average age  $\leq 60$

### RENAL TUMOURS

- Renal cancer  $< 40$
- Bilateral/multifocal tumours
- FDR/SDR with a renal tumour
- Extra renal features suggestive of possible genetic syndrome\*

\*Retinal angioma, PNET, pheochromocytoma, spinal or cerebellar haemangioblastomas, lung cysts, fibrofolliculoma, uterine fibroids, cutaneous leiomyoma, paraganglioma

### ENDOCRINE TUMOURS

- Paraganglioma any age
- Pheochromocytoma  $< 50$  or bilateral phaeo or FDR/SDR with possible related tumour\*\*
- Hyperparathyroidism  $< 35$  or personal hx or FDR/SDR with MEN1 related tumour\*\*
- Pituitary adenoma plus FDR/SDR with MEN1 related tumour\*\*
- PNET  $< 30$  or gastrinoma any age
