## 4) Report from the Guardian of Safe Working (SD)

- Quarterly report due this week
  Since 19<sup>th</sup> Jan 238 trainees on the new contract,
- 250 more by October
- 86 exception reports (115 in last quarter)
- Increase in Medicine Exception Reports
- ES/CS not completing reports
- Pre-31<sup>st</sup> March ER payments will be paid in June

### Rota Gaps -

- No robust information on rota gaps included in annual report
- Suggestion made to obtain rota gap information from staff bank. Staff bank could confirm what shifts have been put out to locum.

Action: Claire Low to discuss obtaining rota gap information from SB with the staff bank manager

### 5) Medical Staffing Update – CL

- Claire Low to format and circulate the Exception Reporting policy
- GP resources approval being sought for additional resources (some approvals already received).
- 75% of rotas completed for August
- Trust grade doctors/CFs will remain on the 2002 contract. Possible future plans to mirror new contract terms for these doctors (Pan London approach)

• Upper GI frame has worked well apart from the odd ER

## Concerns regarding unsafe working and gaps:

- ➤ General Medicine Respiratory F2 rota is 1F2 down
- > ENT has 3 or 4 down on ST1-2
- ➤ Upper GI has 2 ST3+ gaps often have to cross cover as can't get locums
- Diary card monitoring requested
- > AMU negative feedback from consultants re exception reporting
- ➤ Gastro x1 ST3+ down
- Cardiology x2 ST1-2 gap

#### **Locum Cap**

- Medicine OOH staffing on risk register. DL met with AR/SD/DDO to raise the issue.
- Consider using un-banded CFs to fill gaps
