Frequent Northern line trains run from Tooting Broadway to Balham, Clapham Common, Kennington, Waterloo, Charing Cross, Tottenham Court Road, Euston, London Bridge, Bank, Angel, King's Cross, Camden Town and stations to Edgware, High Barnet and Mill Hill East, as well as serving stations to Morden.

Tooting Broadway is a short walk away, or take any bus from stops H1, H3, H4, H5, H6 or H7.

Fully accessible low-floor buses

Low-floor wheelchair accessible buses run on all routes serving St George's Hospital and Tooting Broadway.

Cycles

Taxis and private hire

Taxis and private hire vehicles offer a fantastic door-to-door service available at your convenience, all year round. For your safety, taxis and private hire operators must be licensed to operate legally.

Always ensure you use a licensed taxi or private hire operator. Illegal touts are often uninsured, with their vehicles in poor working order and potentially dangerous.

As a service to patients, the hospital contracts two local taxi operators. You can contact them using the free phone links in the hospital main entrance in the Grosvenor Wing.

Car parking at St George's Hospital

Pay and display car parking is available at St George's Hospital. The charges are paid on exit and are as follows:

- £2 for the first hour with half-hourly charges after that (up to 4 hours)
- £12 over four hours
- £20 over six hours (daily fixed rate)

Concessions are available in special circumstances (please obtain a ticket as normal and then ask your ward or department for details).

Disabled drivers/passengers who hold a blue badge can park free on the perimeter road (around St George's), and in designated spaces on the site.

There are also 30 minute pick up bays outside the Dental/Day Surgery Unit, Grosvenor Wing main entrance and Knightsbridge Wing entrance.

Limited metered parking is available in the streets around St George's Hospital.

Where to buy your ticket, pass or Pre Pay

Ticket Stops are independent retailers selling tickets on behalf of Transport for London. Over 2,200 of these issue Oyster cards and sell a comprehensive range of One Day, Θ 3 Day, 7 Day and monthly Travelcards Ticket Stop and Bus Passes as well as Savers and Pre Pay. They also issue Adult, "5-10", "11-15" and "16-17" photocards.

A further 1,600+ Ticket Stops sell a selected range of One Day Travelcards and Bus Passes as well as Savers and adult rate 7 Day Bus Passes.
















Further help in journey planning
