IDAS has a specialist social work team which is integrated with all of the services IDAS offers. These social workers can offer specialist support to those patients with complex needs, such as mental health, elderly, families and substance misusing parents.

They also support patients that require access to residential rehab placement and undertake carer's assessments. Please contact your local service for further information.

WHAT IS IDAS

IDAS Wandsworth provides a unique, fully integrated drug and alcohol service offering a range of treatments and programmes for its residents.

IDAS is a partnership between KCA and Blenheim CDP who will ensure that every patient has easy access to personalised treatment and the best possible chance to choose recovery and become drug or alcohol free.

The service offers a primary care service in the GP practices across Wandsworth, as well as the services in the four localities.

These are located at:

- St. John's Hill
- Garratt Lane
- Battersea Palmerston Court
- Queen Mary's Hospital

A patient can access IDAS at any one of the four sites. They will start treatment at the service centre they first attend but will be able to use any of the service centres for treatment.

WHAT SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE?

IDAS will work with patients to arrange a treatment package that meets their individual needs. This will be agreed between the patient and their keyworker and will be at the centre of their recovery plan.

The services that IDAS offers are:

- A range of specialist groups including abstinence, gender specific, stimulants and SMART recovery
- Access to a specialist social worker
- Dual-diagnosis work (mental health, drugs and alcohol)
- Access to education, training and employment support
- Counselling and psychological therapies
- Access to housing support
- Open access and drop-in sessions
- Healthcare checks including BBV testing
- Peer mentoring
- Primary care service
- Service user involvement
- Structured day programme (abstinent and non-abstinent)
- Access to community and residential detox and community care assessment for rehab

This service offers an alcohol community detox called 'Fresh Start', working with GPs to deliver medically assisted detox from alcohol.

Those patients in GP care that have higher health needs or more complex misuse are transferred into services at Queen Marys or St Johns for alcohol detox and are assisted by a recovery worker alongside the primary care service.

Clients will be able to access residential detox and rehabilitation through any part of the IDAS service.
