Complex Neuroscience Education Event Led By Clinical Nurse Specialists


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Aim of Educational event:

- To train nurses in managing complex neurosurgical, neurological and neurorehabilitation patients on paediatric wards to improve patient safety
- To understand the impact of Traumatic and Acquired Brain Injury on children and their families and improve patient experience
- To empower nurses in career choice and progression

Method: Two-day learning event of key Paediatric Neurosciences topics organised by Neurosciences CNS in collaboration with Consultants and Senior nurses.

Strategies for learning:



Conclusion: Before the event, many Paediatric nurses on general wards were not very confident in managing Neurosciences patients. This event provided effective teaching, was received positively and took place in a safe environment. Nurses reported feeling empowered to manage Neurosciences patients on **all** Paediatric wards.
