<b>Achievements:</b>	<p>GMC Training Survey 2023 – St George's is again top in England for overall trainee satisfaction, scoring 94%. This is testament to the hard work from the education and rota teams, who took on board trainee concerns about previous lack of training opportunities due to the rota structure amongst other issues. (In 2022 GMC training survey, we had slipped to 8<sup>th</sup> place in England, with overall satisfaction of 84%).</p> <p>All junior and senior clinical fellow posts were filled</p> <p>IMT and junior clinical fellows gave good feedback after being included in the Acute Neurology team</p> <p>New (and first) F2 starting in Neurology and Stroke in August 2023</p>
<b>Issues:</b>	<p>Recruitment to Kent Surrey and Sussex rotation (which rotates through St George's) not fully successful. Will have minor implication for our rota.</p>
<b>Plans for next quarter:</b>	<p>Continue to monitor nationwide reorganisation of posts (currently with Central Committee) and mitigate any effect on St George's.</p> <p>Continue to iterate rota and training programme promptly in response to concerns and issues raised by the trainees.</p> <p>Continue implementation of new curriculum – this is the first year with multiple trainees on this curriculum – likely to be learning points, but good structure and training in preparation.</p>



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
