A childhood cancer diagnosis is devastating.

Parents need to know their children are in the best possible hands and have access to the right support. That assurance is precisely what we provide here at St George's, where we have providing specialist children's cancer care for more than 25 years.

In the past year alone, we have treated over 170 young patients living with cancer across South London, Kent, Medway, Surrey, Sussex, and beyond.

NHS England is running a public consultation regarding the future location of children's cancer services. St George's is one of the two options available.

Closing our children's cancer service and locating services elsewhere will have a significant knock-on effect on our other children's services.

This is because the clinical staff who care for children with cancer also care for other children. so if the service moves to the Evelina it will impact other children's services at St George's. Keeping the service in south west London avoids this.
